 The theme-based working groups will share their expert knowledge on the challenges and prospects of the aerosol industry on their markets. For the first time, a session in the afternoon will be devoted to the theme of aerosol development for cosmetics. Lectures will be chaired by Isabelle Lepeltier, DGT, L'Oréal.

This first day will finish with a cocktail party for exhibitors, participants and speakers, a friendly time for exchanges. Wednesday, 9th March, 2011, Nathalie Thys, Aerosol Production Manager, GSK, will chair the session on health products and spray techniques for the aerosol industry, delving deeper into the points covered at the preceding edition.

This session will be followed by the yearly Paris Aerosol Awards ceremony, which will single out innovative aerosol products placed on the market between the 1st January and the 31st December 2010. Finally, the session on the specificities and prospects for propellants will close this second day of the exhibition. Pierre Goffinet, Ifraq France, will chair this session.
